


America saw, and America approved. As a result, purchases of Delta 88 and Ninety-Eight by big-car buyers have substantially increased for two consecutive years.

AN EFFICIENT SIZE

These new-generation Oldsmobiles offer the advantage of space efficiency far advanced over their predecessors. They are shorter in wheelbase, reduced in overhang, easier to handle in crowded city traffic. Yet all have significantly improved headroom and legroom, front and rear, over their earlier-designed counterparts.

The trunk has been engineered to be space-efficient, too, with a flat floor and room to accommodate large

A SOLID, SECURE RIDE

An ultimate test of a big car traditionally has been its ride—its ability to gently cradle you over rough roads or boulevards with equal ease. So the

challenge was to maintain that composure in trimmer, more weightefficient cars.

With the aid of sophisticated finite analysis computer technology, many components were "road tested" through computer simulation and fine-tuned at the design stage. Deeptravel suspension systems and front suspensions with inherent directional

stability were developed to maintain the traditional big-car ride.

What you experience on the road is a sophisticated kind of luxurious ride, made even more impressive by the fact that it was achieved by ingenious engineering—reducing, not adding, weight.

A RELAXING SENSE OF QUIET

A quiet, relaxing atmosphere is another prized hallmark of a finely engineered and built car. Shutting out the noisy outside world only heightens your sense of luxury as you drive along on the road.

Modern acoustics technology has been incorporated in the design of these cars. The ceiling above you is a specially designed acoustical barrier. Super-soft door seals help shut out the noise of passing traffic. Even the thick, lush carpeting is cut in a single piece to further help insulate you from road noise.

Try this little test when you first drive a 1979 Oldsmobile: once underway, turn the radio off and the fan down, and experience the sense of quiet. Then open the window a bit and listen to the noise of the outside world. Close it again and enjoy the peace advanced engineering has created for you. You can hold a quiet conversation here. Or, with a choice of available radios, enjoy the richness of stereo music.

DEEP-SEATED COMFORT

The benefits of engineering are not limited to the mechanical aspects of your travel—you will enjoy them in the creature comforts of the 1979 Oldsmobiles as well.

Notice the seat height, and the angles of the seat cushion and back. Sit in the back seat and note the kneeroom, legroom and footroom you have. If the car is a coupe, notice too, as you enter the back, there are no seat-back latches to fumble for—just tilt the seat-back forward, and step to the rear with ease.

IMPRESSIVE DRIVEABILITY

Oldsmobile also believes that America expects a Delta 88, 98 or Toronado to be more than luxurious and comfortable—it must be a great road car that will maintain its poise in bad weather or on a difficult stretch of winding road.



Last year, Olds introduced the 5.7litre diesel V8 as the world's first in a passenger car. This year, Oldsmobile has expanded its availability to include the all-new Toronado as well.

What makes it so special? It saves like a diesel... runs like a V8... because it's both. The 5.7-litre diesel combines basic economy of a diesel with performance you might not expect from a diesel—thanks to its V8 configuration. And you may order it in Toronado or any Ninety-Eight, Delta 88 or Custom Cruiser.

DIESEL MEANS FUEL ECONOMY

The EPA mileage estimates on the accompanying engine supplement sheet will demonstrate the substantially better mileage you can expect with a diesel, compared to the same Olds with a gasoline engine. But that's not all.

You can also expect less cost per gallon, based on the traditionally lower price for diesel fuel than for unleaded gasoline.

More miles per gallon . . . less cost per gallon. That's what this 5.7 diesel V8 is all about.

SURPRISING PERFORMANCE

In the past, diesel cars have not been



known for their response, acceleration or smoothness. But you'll be pleasantly surprised by a 5.7-litre diesel V8 powered Oldsmobile.

The 5.7-litre diesel V8 delivers one of the highest power-to-weight ratios among diesel cars on the road today.

Unlike gasoline V8s, the diesel V8 has no spark plugs. No distributor. No carburetor. So it eliminates the need to service or replace these items. And it meets current emission standards without a catalytic converter.

Furthermore, its special requirements for regular maintenance are very simple. Just change oil and filter every 3000 miles, and check crankcase ventilation every 6000 miles. Other than that, its schedules are similar to other Oldsmobiles.
