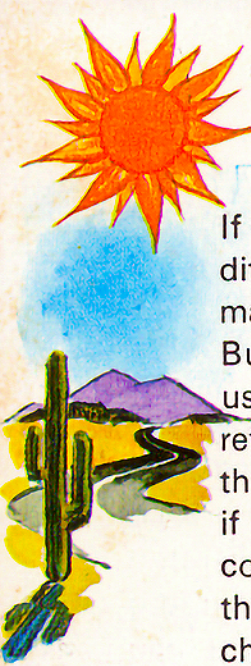




Your Guide to OLDSMOBILE CARE

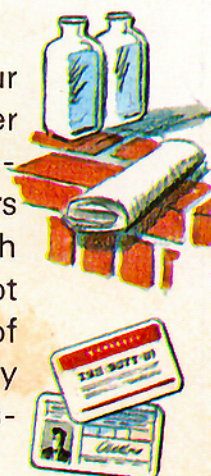


If your Oldsmobile is equipped with air conditioning, you know what a big difference it makes in your hot weather driving comfort. But, do you also know that in a year's normal use, the system might lose up to a pound of refrigerant? Dirt and insects which block the condenser affect the unit's operation. So, if it has been some time since your car's air conditioner has been inspected, we suggest that you have one of our service technicians check it over. He will check refrigerant level and add as required, clean the condenser, adjust the compressor belt tension, and make certain that the entire system is in good working order. It's a quick way to make sure that you'll enjoy cool, comfortable motoring no matter how high the temperature gets outside.



Chuck holes, rough grade crossings, curbs—these are among the often unavoidable bumps and jolts that can cause a front wheel misalignment. But, unless the wheels are seriously out of alignment, you may not even be aware that the problem exists. So, in order to make certain that your Oldsmobile will handle properly at all times, we highly recommend that you come in periodically for an alignment and wheel balance check by our factory-trained service technicians.
